RE: Texas House Bill 724 (7th) Meeting

The (7th) meeting of the Unclaimed Mineral Proceeds Commission will happen on Friday, November 21, 2014 at 10:00 AM in the **Texas State Capitol Auditorium**. Anyone interested on attending should be there before 10:00 AM because it promptly starts on time.

The presiding officer of the commission is Corpus Christi Attorney Lance Bruun. Bruun stated that years ago, one family wanted him to represent them in a land grant claim. Bruun said, "This is a sad story because the family that came to see me absolutely believed, in their heart of hearts, that there was money for them..... lots of money. The reality is that's just not true. It can't happen."

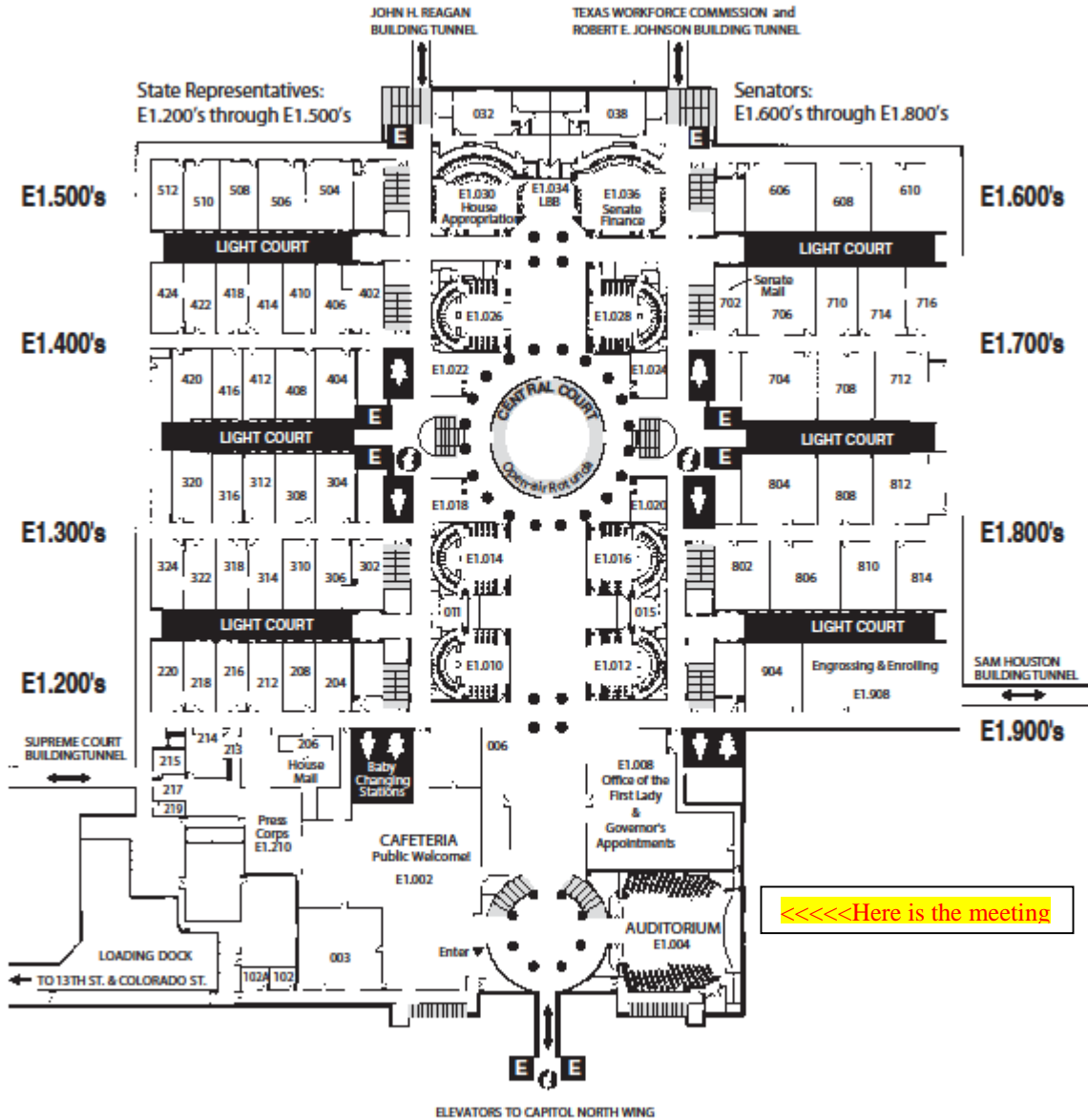
In the video Bruun said the Texas Comptroller's Office could have more than \$330 million in unclaimed mineral proceeds. To be eligible, you would have to prove you are a legal heir to the owner of land which is connected to those proceeds. 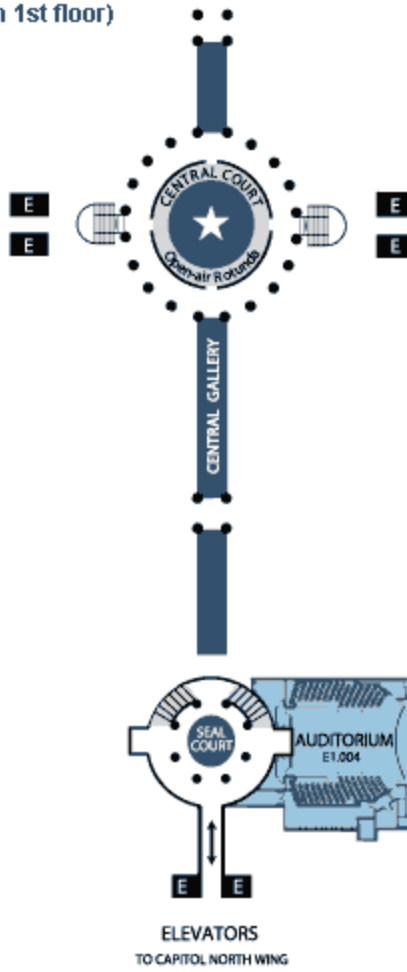
